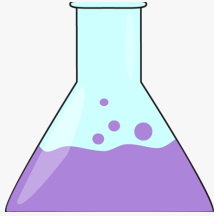

Wearing the school uniform complies with our Sun Smart Skin Protection Policy.

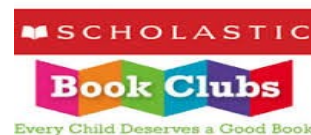
From the Finance Office
