Dear Parents/Caregivers,

A note will be sent home to parents during the next week seeking your assistance in completing the 2017 Craigmore South Primary School Parent Opinion Survey. This is a Federal and State Government requirement and we must show feedback from these surveys in the Annual Report for 2017. The surveys are very easy to complete and should take no longer than 5 minutes. All parents will receive a letter that has the website address of the survey and a unique code to gain access. Once this code has been used it cannot be used again. The survey is completely anonymous as the codes have been given out at random. We ask parents to complete the surveys this week.

I would also like to remind parents about the *School Colour Fun Run* note that was sent home earlier this week. Parents can find copies of these notes on their smart phone, if they have the Skoolbag App or they can request a new note from the front office. We will assume that you have given permission for your child to attend if we have not heard from you. In this event students are splashed with non toxic colour powders and water as they run and raise funds for the school. Students will not be splashed with colour if they are in school uniform or other clothing that is clearly not for this purpose. If you have objections to your child/ren taking part in this event please contact the school or complete the permission note so we can comply with your wishes.

Finally we would like to remind parents that there will be a pupil free day on **Monday 13th November** for the whole staff to train in Basic Emergency Life Support. We want all our staff trained in the best ways to support people while in a medical emergency. This is not only important for your children but also important for staff and parents should any of us be in the unfortunate circumstance of requiring medical assistance at school.

School Uniform Reminder

Now that we are in our summer term, we would like to remind families uniform items are available for purchase from the front office.

All shorts, skirts, pants and leggings must be plain black (no logos or stripes) These items can be purchased from local department stores.

All shorts must be of a **RESPECTABLE** length. (inappropriate length will not be tolerated) Hats must be worn everyday. Many students are coming to the office asking to borrow a spare hat. We do not have spare hats. The cost ranges from \$5.00 — \$10.00. Please make sure your child has a hat.

Dear Parents,

Craigmore South is offering Scholastic Book Club in 2017. For the first time we will be implementing LOOP, linked online ordering and payment, where parents using credit card pay and place their order online. This service will save school staff time in facilitating book club, enabling us to spend more time working with students. We encourage all parents to use LOOP but we will still accept cash payments for book club items as we have in the past. Please be reminded there is **no obligation to purchase**; book club is an optional service.

If you would like to participate, now with LOOP, ordering is easier than ever before! For further details on how to use LOOP, please refer to the back of this letter.

Just look over the catalogue with your child and select the items you like.

You can place an order 1 of 2 ways

ONLINE ORDERS -Place and pay for your order online with your credit card using **LOOP**, linked ordering and online payment, new to Scholastic Book Club. For instructions on how to use **LOOP**, please refer to the directions on the back of this letter. **If you are paying using LOOP there is no need to return your paper order form to school, our staff can track your orders online**

CASH ORDERS- To pay with cash, simply complete the order form on the back of your catalogue and return with your cash payment in a secure zip lock bag or sealed envelope to your class teacher.

ORDERS MUST ARRIVE BACK TO SCHOOL AS PER THE DUE DATE advertised by signage posted around the school.

The books will arrive around two weeks after close of ordering and will be sent home with your child. Each order helps earn free books and teaching materials for our classroom. If you have any questions regarding Scholastic Book Club please contact your Book Club Organiser.

Just over three-quarters of parents (78%) agree they wish their child would read more books for fun; a similar number of kids (76%), across ages, say they know they should read more books for fun.

From the Finance Office

Material & Service Fees 2016

Your child's Material & Service Fees were due on April 13th 2017.

All outstanding invoices have now been forwarded to Central Debt Recovery.

Once DECD Recovery Service processes the school's claims you will not be able to pay your fees here at school and it will be more difficult for you to organise payments. Please consider this fact for 2018 and organise a payment plan with us if you have difficulty paying. Small weekly/fortnightly payments are welcome.
