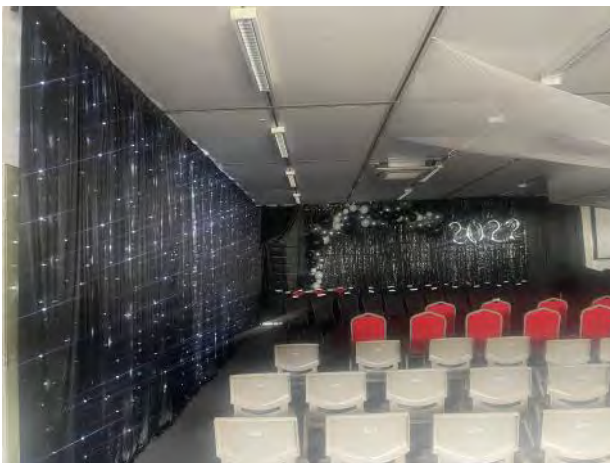
Farewells

IMPORTANT NEWS FROM THE FINANCE OFFICE

Material & Service Fees 2022

Your child's Material & Service Fees were due on April 8th 2022.

Outstanding invoices have now been forwarded to Central Debt Recovery.

Once DfE Recovery Service processes the school's claims you will not be able to pay your fees here at school and it will be more difficult for you to organise payments. Please consider this fact for 2023 and organise a payment plan with us if you have difficulty paying. Small weekly/fortnightly payments are welcome.

Material & Service Fees 2023

Final approval of the School Material and Service Charges was approved at the Governing Council Meeting 31st October 2022.

The M&S Fees for 2023 will be \$269.00 which is an increase of \$16.00. The M&S Fees also incorporate the Reception to Year 5's swimming fees. The Year 6 component assists with the Camp subsidy.

Please Note: If your child/ren do not attend the swimming or camp the component of M&S will still be used to support these activities.

Invoices will be sent home early next year.

School Card applications must be applied for every year and submitted ONLINE. 2023 will be available from late January.

No paper applications will be accepted by the Department except for Change of Circumstances, Hardship or Reassessment.

To assist you with your online application a staff member will be available at the front office from the 31st January 2023.

This support will continue throughout term 1.

Please ensure you bring your Centrelink details (CRN numbers) with you.

Please do not hesitate to come in and use our access and support to ensure your School Card application is lodged and processed in a timely manner. We would prefer that School Card applications be lodged before the end of Term 1 2023.

- OSHC will be open from 8:30am – 6:00pm, please sign in and out between these times.
- All bookings must be received by Monday 12th December to avoid a \$3 casual fee.
- Cancellations must be made two weeks prior to the date of requested care to avoid payment.
- Please send children in appropriate clothes for the activity they will be participating in.
- Sun Smart guidelines are followed so please ensure a hat is worn and no sunglasses.
- Sunscreen is provided. If your child is sensitive to sunscreen, please provide your own.
- Please review our terms and conditions online for our fee and policy information.
- Please provide morning tea, lunch and a drink bottle every day unless stated otherwise.
- Please note that we are a NUT-aware centre.
- Breakfast and afternoon tea will be provided.
- Handheld electronic devices are not permitted at the centre unless specified in the day's description, communication devices are allowed.
- We welcome feedback and suggestions at any time, please see your centre staff.
- By making a booking you are agreeing to pay the fees through your direct debit account in addition to normal OSHC bookings.
- Please inform the service if your child suffers from travel sickness.
- Programmed activities are subject to change.
