The program provides an opportunity for primary school aged children from Reception to Year 7 to receive up to a \$50 discount on sports membership/registration fees. - All bookings must be received by Monday 10th April to avoid a \$3 casual fee.

- Sun Smart guidelines are followed so please ensure a hat is worn and no singlets.
- Sunscreen is provided. If your child is sensitive to sunscreen, please provide your own.
- Please review our terms and conditions online for our fee and policy information.
- Please provide morning tea, lunch and a drink bottle every day unless stated otherwise.
- Please note that we are a NUT-aware centre.
- Breakfast and afternoon tea will be provided.
- Handheld electronic devices are not permitted at the centre unless specified in the day's description, communication devices are allowed.
- We welcome feedback and suggestions at any time, please see your centre staff
- By making a booking you are agreeing to pay the fees through your direct debit account in addition to normal OSHC bookings
- Please inform the service if your child suffers from travel sickness.
